

Disable Fly-In Animations for One-at-a-Time Interaction

Do you like the [one-at-a-time interaction](#) but you're not a fan of the fly-in animations that are part of this interaction? Never fear, we've got some CSS Code to disable these animations!

It's as easy as copying and pasting the below CSS code in your theme.

1. To do so, go to your survey's **Style** tab and scroll to the bottom of the survey preview to access the link for the **HTML/CSS Editor**.
2. The CSS should be pasted in the field on the **Custom CSS** tab.
