

Understanding Time Started and Date Submitted in your responses

By default, Alchemer surveys record both the date and time the response was started and the date and time the response was submitted.

Time Started is the date and time the respondent clicked the first Next or Submit button in your survey. If you have a one page survey the Time Started and Date Submitted will be the same.

Date Submitted is the date and time the respondent last clicked a Next or Submit button in your survey. This may or may not be the last page in your survey. If it is a Partial response it will be the date and time for the last page they submitted.

These times are available in the time zone you specify for the application in [Individual Responses](#) and [Exports](#).

As of September 19, 2016, the **Time Started** and **Date Submitted** fields in **CSV / Excel Exports** will reflect the Time Zone and Date/Time Format settings of your Alchemer account. These settings can be adjusted by an Account Administrator under **Account Settings > General**.
