

Customize Your Account Time Zone

- For US accounts your default account time zone will be set to the New York time zone or EST/EDT (GMT -5/GMT -4). The switch from EST to EDT and back is performed as scheduled according to [Daylight Saving Time in the US](#) (no other Daylight Saving Time Observances are followed e.g. BST).
- For EU accounts your default time zone will be set to Abidjan (GMT).

If you wish to customize the time zone for your account, select **Account > Settings**. This is an admin-only feature, please reach out to your Account Administrator to make this change if you do not see the option. This will change the time zone for all users on the account.

There are some additional locality settings available here as well. If you wish to customize the Date/Time Format as it displays in the application you can do so here. Finally, your Default Currency and Default Project Language can be set here.

Individual Responses

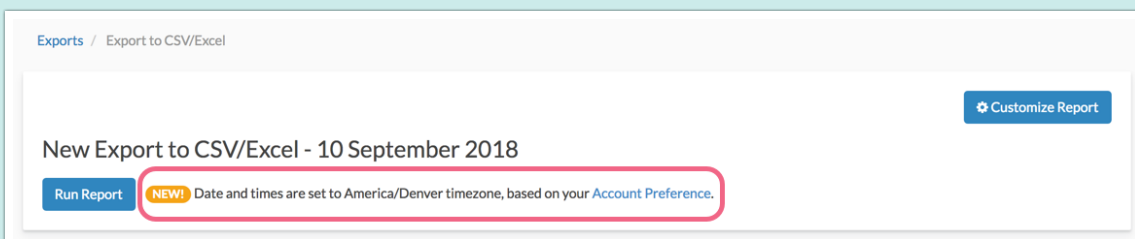

As of September 19, 2016 the **Time Started** and **Date Submitted** fields in **CSV / Excel Exports** will reflect the Time Zone and Date/Time Format settings of your Alchemer account.

Automatically Close Survey

Email Campaign Open Date/Close Date

When scheduling the open and close date of an email campaign, this will be specified in your specified time zone with 24-hour time format.
