

Restrict API Access

API access and API access controls are only available to enterprise customers. If you are interested, please [contact us](#) for more information!

The [Alchemer API](#) (Application Programming Interface) is used to integrate Alchemer into just about anything. Account Administrators can restrict access to the API altogether or restrict specific types of calls.

To get to these settings, from the Left Hand Navigation menu click **Security > API Access**.

API Access Rules

Allow API access.
 Do not allow any API access.

API Access Rules

Do not allow API GET calls.
 Do not allow API PUT calls.
 Do not allow API POST calls.
 Do not allow API DELETE calls.
 Do not allow access to the API using OAUTH authentication.
